CHAPLAIN

BASIC FUNCTION:

The chaplain shall conduct the chapter's religious and/or creed exercises and encourage the holistic wellness of members of the chapter. In accordance with their efforts to support the overall health of chapter members, the position oversees the chapter's active engagement with topics of diversity and inclusion (D&I) through providing educational opportunities for chapter members and ensuring that Phi Delta Theta remains inclusive in all aspects of chapter activities.

TEN THINGS TO FOCUS ON AS CHAPLAIN:

1. Prepare and present as a primer to the chapter meeting thought-provoking literary exercises to encourage members to engage with critical thought, pulling from a diverse reading of materials: academic, political, and/or spiritual texts.
 2. Connect the chapter with campus resources regarding mental health (MH), including counseling center resources, crisis management hotlines, and supplemental educational programming.
 3. Utilize GHQ and campus support to assess and improve the chapter's engagement with diversity and inclusion topics.
 4. Provide opportunities for spiritual/philosophical and emotional growth for chapter members
 5. Plan and execute various educational opportunities to inform members on D&I and MH, with at least one educational program each term/semester (per topic).
 6. Work with various committees, including but not limited to recruitment, Phikeia education, and social committees, to ensure that MH and D&I are considered within their work.
 7. Serve as a trusted mediator for members of the chapter and be prepared to connect members with various campus resources.
 8. Be familiar with *The Code of Phi Delta Theta*, chapter bylaws, and campus expectations and their impact on work surrounding D&I and mental health initiatives
 9. Advocate members of the chapter and the executive board on the importance of MH and D&I work in the chapter.
 10. Ensure that Phi Delta Theta remains non-discriminatory in all aspects of chapter activities.
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
