CHAPTER ADVISORY BOARD RECRUITMENT

Build Rapport & Screen

Utilize the following questions to assist with building rapport & assist with initial screening:

- Φ Tell me about your college experience?
- Φ Why did you join Phi Delta Theta?
- Φ How has Phi Delta Theta influenced your life?
- Φ Have you ever volunteered for Phi Delta Theta or any other student-based organizations?
- Φ Why do you think you would be an effective volunteer?
- Φ What do you think is the single most reason a chapter will succeed?

Review Positions

Ask the following questions before reviewing positions:

- Φ Have you been able to review the different roles and responsibilities of the CAB positions?
- Φ Are there any specific volunteer positions you're interested in? Why?

Review CAB Top 10 documents related to position interest, then ask:

- Φ What part of the responsibilities we reviewed stood out the most to you?
- Φ Was there anything that surprised you or seemed difficult to accomplish?

Next Steps

Utilize these tactics to ensure proper follow-up & next steps:

- Φ Connect them with the chapters Province Presidents and existing CAB members
- Φ Assist with connect the potential volunteer to chapter leadership
- Φ Send a follow-up email thanking them for meeting with you and expressing interest
- Φ Contact Province President to ensure proper follow up
- Φ If placed on CAB, send volunteer contact information to Chapter Support Coordinator:
