IDEAL MEMBERSHIP CRITERIA

Having membership criteria is a good practice to ensure the quality of your chapters new and current members, regardless of quantity. Below you will find Phi Delta Theta's recommendations on the ideal characteristics and criteria a potential new member should achieve before receiving an invitation to join.



ACADEMICS & SCHOLARSHIP

Achieve a minimum collegiate grade point average of 2.75

—or—

Achieve a minimum high school grade point average of 3.0



LEADERSHIP & INVOLVEMENT

Hold at least one leadership role within an organization on or off campus

—or—

Involved in at least two extracurricular activities on or off campus



SERVICE & PHILANTHROPY

Provide proof of personal involvement in a community service event

—or—

Provide proof of personal dollars raised through philanthropic efforts



AREAS TO CONSIDER FOR LOCAL MEMBERSHIP CRITERIA

PNM Interviews: Host interviews with potential new members to review membership expectations and determine fit

Diversity: Determine if the potential new members bring something to the chapter that the current membership is lacking. This can include a person's major, background, networks, belief, etc.

Personal References: Ask a potential new member to provide a letter of recommendation from a professional associate or acquaintance
